PUBLIC HEARING

Regarding Use of CDBG Funds

The City of Somerton intends to apply for Fiscal Year 2019 CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing State Special Projects (SSP) Account in the amount not to exceed \$500,000. CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need.

A public hearing will be held to gather citizen input on the use of the CDBG SSP funds on:

Examples or possible uses include the following:

- **Public Facilities & Improvements** (e.g., water, wastewater and street improvements);
- **Community Facilities** (e.g., parks, health clinics, libraries, senior or youth centers);
- **Housing** (e.g., owner-occupied or multi-family rehab, utility connections of private property, new housing constructed by a non-profit);
- **Economic Development** (e.g., a loan to a business for job creation, micro-enterprise development, acquisition of land for an existing business expansion); and
- **Engineering Plans, Architecture Plans or Environmental Review Records** (for projects that will be implemented through the applicant's next Regional Account application (s)).
